Purpose

This policy outlines the circumstances when Ripponlea Kindergarten's Bush Kinder program will be cancelled.

Values

Ripponlea Kindergarten is committed to:

- ensuring the safety and wellbeing of all children attending Bush Kinder
- meeting its duty of care obligations under the law.

Scope

This policy applies to parents, staff, committee members, people authorised to collect children, volunteers and students on placement working at Ripponlea Kindergarten.

Procedures

Bush Kinder runs all year round. It will be cancelled only in times of extreme weather or due to staff assessment of suitability on the day:

- forecast temperature is 35°C or greater
- forecast wind speed greater than 45km per hour
- forecast electrical/thunderstorms activity
- Bureau of Meteorology weather warnings of extreme storm conditions, excessive rainfall, dust storms, hail storms or other extreme weather forecasts
- Environment Protection Authority Victoria advice of very poor or hazardous air quality

Staff will notify parents via Kindyhub if the session is cancelled and held back at home kinder. This may occur on the day of session, either before it starts, or mid-session. Staff will cancel mid-session only if conditions deteriorate significantly. Parents will be notified by SMS or phone call.

Staff will assess local conditions on site and consult the following apps and websites:

Evaluation

To assess whether the policy has achieved the values and purposes we will:

- seek feedback about this policy and its implementation from parents of children participating in the Bush Kinder program. This can be facilitated through discussions and the annual survey
- ask staff to share their experiences and observations about the effectiveness of this policy
- regularly review the policy and Kinder practices to ensure they comply with any new legislation, research or best practice procedures.
